A first impression is most certainly a once-off luxury, never to be repeated again. 50% of clients will make an instant decision on whether or not they are interested in your property just by what they see at the onset, from the outside..

Outside:

- ✓ Tidy up your garden / yard cut the grass, trim edges, clean flowerbeds, trim shrubs & over growth, discard dead plants & garden rubbish (you do not need to have a designer garden just a well kept, neat one)
- ✓ Remove your pets & their droppings
- ✓ Keep your swimming pool sparkling clean
- ✓ Clean garden furniture & display with bright cushions / umbrellas (remove dirt, rust, torn cushions, etc)
- ✓ Pack away garden tools, other clutter
- ✓ Pack away kids' toys, bicycles, etc.
- ✓ Check, wash, paint or repair gutters, woodwork, window frames & ledges, garage doors, roof, roof tiles, gates, burglar bars, outside light fittings & bulbs, fences, steps, sprinklers
- ✓ Wash windows & exterior walls, replace broken windows
- ✓ Repair leaking taps
- ✓ Oil squeaking hinges
- ✓ Ensure no loose or unsightly wires are hanging from your property on the outside
- ✓ Ensure the dish or TV antenna is securely fixed.
- ✓ Ensure that the roof does not leak
- ✓ Clean & un-clutter your garages
- ✓ Ensure the outside quarters are clean & not smelly
- ✓ Clear the pathway from your entrance gate to the front door of your property buyers want to access your property without effort
- ✓ Lock pets away safely so that they do not annoy or threaten visitors.
- ✓ Make sure the entrance to your house leaves a good impression! Ensure the door bell is working!

Inside: (Appeal to all the senses of the potential buyer – they want a new home)

- ✓ Spring clean your house, freshen up appearances
- ✓ Pack away clutter / loose articles/ toys & throw away junk, old magazines (you might be moving soon anyway
 – get a head start)
- ✓ Vacuum all animal hairs from your furniture & carpets. Wash & clean animal bedding & cages
- ✓ Wash carpets and mats if necessary
- ✓ Fix up what is broken / faulty lampshades, bulbs, switches, electrical plugs, leaking taps & toilets, loose door handles, window arms & latches, curtain rails, oil squeaking hinges & doors, unclog drains, broken mirrors & tiles
- ✓ Repair fine cracks with filler & paint where necessary
- ✓ Ensure bathrooms are gleaming and clean no grime, no mould, no odours, etc. Put some potpourri, essence or good smelling soap in the bathrooms, but do not over do.
- Ensure towels in bathrooms are fresh and clean. Put fresh linen on beds and ensure all beds are made
- ✓ Neutralise cigarette / tobacco odours brew some coffee, bake a pie, fry some onions...
- ✓ Open all curtains and windows to let fresh air and sufficient light into the house
- ✓ Switch on all lights (especially at night)
- ✓ Turn the TV or music down (restful music will aid a good feeling). Create a warm, friendly & homely feeling. Do not shout at your animals, your kids or your spouse you can do that later
- ✓ Control inside temperature if at all possible especially during winter months
- ✓ Place mirrors strategically to illuminate dark corners
- ✓ Kitchen, oven, sink, counters & floor must be spotlessly clean NO dirty dishes standing around
- ✓ Put some fresh flowers in a vase (especially on show days) if possible.
- ✓ Do not tag along and do not allow your children to tag along either your agent is well equipped to inform buyers of all the features of your property. Do not interfere. Allow the agent to do his / her job.

Ask yourself – would I fall in love with this property if I saw it for the first time?
